For over 40 years, Grove Cottage has provided social and educational activities for people with learning difficulties. These activities provide lifelong friendship groups for the members and respite for their families. Children attend the Special Needs Nursery as soon as they are diagnosed until they transfer to a state school at five years old. Older children attend the Saturday Clubs for five to eight year olds and then for over-eights. Later they transfer to the adult clubs which meet in the evenings. Grove Cottage has a multi-purpose hall, a sensory room, a cozy lounge, a computer area and a minibus to transport members to the centre and take them on outings.

CAZFEST



Every week in the UK at least 12 apparently 'fit and healthy' young people die of undiagnosed heart conditions. In 2008 at just 17 Caroline Johnstone (Caz) was just one of those people. In order that she is not just a statistic the CAZ programme was launched.

In memory of Caroline, Cazfest was founded to raise awareness of Cardiac Death in the Young and the benefits of heart screening for Bishop's Stortford and the surrounding area. Many of the causes of these sudden deaths can now be detected by a simple and inexpensive screening. Cazfest is dedicated to providing heart screening facilities for all young adults in the Bishop's Stortford area.
